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# Safety Tips for Open Burning



01)Never Burn when it is to windy

- 02) Always have a water hose with a sprayer on it.
- 03) Try not to Smoke Out your neighbors.
  - 04) Make Fires Small add more as it burns down (4 ft X 4 ft)
  - 05) When Starting The Fire DO NOT Use Gasoline!! Instead Use Diesel Fuel.

# 06) Burn only natural vegetation

Wear gloves and keep tools available to fluff the pile up as needed.
