Dear Harbor Point Residents:

This is a friendly reminder.

Please call the Security Gate @ 936-594-2099 if you are expecting a Guest, Delivery Service (other than, UPS, FedEx, DSL), Contractor, or having Dirt, Rock, Concrete etc. delivered. This is for YOUR Protection as well as your Neighbors.

For a Guest. You MUST Notify the Security Gate of your Guest Name and how long they will be staying. They will be given a "Temporary" Guest Pass that MUST be displayed on the front left side of their windshield. This will allow your Guest to come and go without being stopped every time they enter.

Guest/s that will be here for a few hours or just the day, will not need a Temporary pass. Only those staying over night or longer will need a "Temporary Pass".

If the Security Gate is NOT Notified. Your Guest will NOT be permitted to enter Harbor Point. They will be asked to Turn Around and leave until YOU notify the Security Gate.

For Property Owners who have "Temporary" Guest (such as Family or Friends) staying Overnight or a Week or Longer. Notify the Security Gate of your Guest Name and how long they will be staying. They can write those Dates (i.e. 08-15-17 to 10-02-17) on the "Temporary Pass" and already have it made out when your Guest arrives. This will help the line not to back-up.

Also, ALL Property Owners MUST have a Harbor Point Sticker or "Temporary Guest Pass" placed on the left side of your Front windshield at ALL Times! If you do not display your Sticker. You WILL be Stopped each time you try to enter.

Also. Remember, Property Owners who are not current on their Maintenance Fees or who are not Displaying a Current Sticker or "Temporary Pass" will NOT be allowed to use the Facilities (i.e. Boat Ramp, Boat Dock, Piers, Club House, Swimming Pool, etc) and neither will their Guest.

Please remember to contact the Harbor Point POA Office at 936-594-7853 to make sure we have your updated Phone Numbers, Current Address and Email Address (if you have one). We need to be able to get in contact with you in case of an Emergency or if there is a problem that needs your immediate attention. You can also do this on our New Website:

"harborpointtrinity.com" under the "Contact Us Page".

So, we ask that you PLEASE be Considerate of your Neighbors and Guest/s and not be the one that causes the Entrance Line to back up. No one likes to sit in line.

GOLF CART RULES

- 1. **Golf Cart owner** agrees to release Harbor Point Property Owners Assn. and its Board Members of any liability caused by a golf cart or to a golf cart from any **HPPOA** facility.
- 2. There will be no alcoholic beverages on golf carts.
- Commercial manufactured golf carts only. (no homebuilt)
 - Gas powered (4 cycle) or electric golf carts are allowed.
 - 1. Gas powered golf carts must be
 - maintained to factory specifications and NO modifications to engine or muffler system; no fuel or oil leaks
 - 3. Maximum speed will be 20 mph.
- 4. **All golf carts** must be of four- wheeled style.
- 5. **Only golf carts** equipped with both front and rear lights may be operated after dark.
- 6. All cart owners are required to follow all rules pertaining to any other type motor vehicle and have a valid driver's license. In order to operate carts on our streets, children under 16 must be accompanied by licensed driver in front seat. Children with Learner's Permit must have licensed driver in front seat.
- 7. A flag on a 6-foot pole must be mounted on the rear of each golf cart
- 8. All carts require a unique sticker (no longer the same as for our motor vehicles). The fee of \$5.00 will be charged twice a year for each golf cart, and due at the same time as property dues. Valid sticker is purple or red. You must also use the numbered stickers given by the office when you register your golf cart on the vehicle either on the bottom of the windshield or a conspicuous place on the body of the cart. You keep that number as long as you have that golf cart and it is in running condition.
- Please notify the office if you sell/destroy/remove the golf cart from **Harbor Point** so that we do not continue to bill you.
- 10. All of the above rules will be enforced, and a signed copy will be put in a permanent file.

Recipes

SHRIMP BOIL PASTA

1 lb. uncooked gemelli or casarecce pasta

16 oz. smoked sausage, cut into ½ inch-thick slices

2 cups chicken broth

2 cups fresh corn kernels (about 3 ears)

2 lb. raw peeled and deveined large shrimp

2 ½ tsp. Old Bay seasoning

1 TBSP. fresh thyme leaves

1 bunch scallions, sliced (about a cup)

2 TBSP. fresh lemon juice (from 1 lemon)

Cook pasta in salted water according to package directions. Drain and transfer to a large serving bowl, cover to keep warm. While pasta cooks, cook sausage in a Dutch over medium high stirring occasionally, until browned, about 5 minutes. Drain and discard pan drippings. Stir in broth and corn. Bring to a boil and reduce heat to medium-low, and simmer, until corn is tender-crisp, about 5 minutes. Add shrimp and Old Bay seasoning to sausage mixture, stir to combine. Cover and cook until shrimp are done, 2-4 minutes. Remove from heat, and stir in scallions and lemon juice. Add shrimp mixture to pasta, toss gently to combine. Sprinkle with thyme.

BLUEBERRY QUICK BREAD WITH VANILLA SAUCE

1 large egg

1 cup milk

3 tablespoons vegetable oil

2 cups all-purpose flour

1 cup sugar

2 ½ teaspoons baking powder

½ teaspoon salt

2 cups fresh blueberries

Vanilla Sauce

1 cup sugar

1 tablespoon corn starch

1 cup heavy whipping cream

½ cup butter cubed

1 teaspoon vanilla extract

In a large bowl, beat egg, milk and oil. Combine flour, sugar, baking powder and salt; gradually add to the egg mixture, beating just until combined. Fold in blueberries.

Pour into a greased 9X5 inch loaf pan. Bake at 350 for 50-55 minutes or until a toothpick inserted near the center comes out clean. Cool for 10 minutes before removing from pan to a wire rack to cool completely.

For sauce, combine sugar and cornstarch in a saucepan. Stir in cream until smooth; add butter. Bring to a boil over medium heat; cook and stir for 2 minutes or until thickened. Stir in vanilla. Serve with blueberry bread.
